NOTES TO REVIEWERS

The Employee Evaluation Form for 2024-2025 is more detailed than last year's form. The descriptions under Performance Categories have, in most cases, been expanded to assist you in your reflections on the employee's performance, as well as to help guide your discussions during the formal review meeting.

Also incorporated, at the very outset, is a section related to the job description. Since performance should always relate to the duties of a job, it's important to keep the job description updated. This is only fair to the employee, since he or she deserves to know what they're being evaluated on. It's very common for jobs to evolve over time, so that what the job consisted of originally is no longer what the job currently covers. Please list any areas that have changed and, where appropriate, provide an updated job description. Clarity of expectations is a prerequisite for high performance.

Also included is a section related to goals. Every job, and every department, should have defined goals which are updated every year. High performing organizations set individual, departmental, and organizational goals to drive continuous improvement, and related also to the overall mission of the organization. In our diocese, the overall mission is to implement the Bishop's priorities faithfully and in a manner reflective of how he would accomplish them, and ultimately to advance the mission of the Church. This requires ongoing reflection both personally and organizationally, which is why there is a new section focusing on goals and objectives this year.

Lastly, the scale used for the employee evaluation has evolved to make the levels clearer to both supervisor and employee.

It is essential that you devote adequate time and effort to a fair and impartial review, and an honest discussion with your employee. One of the primary reasons for employee dissatisfaction and turnover is the failure to provide timely and regular feedback, both positive and negative. Please use this opportunity well!
